Our purpose is to have safe clean racing, to run hard and, have fun and **not spend a lot of money**. And Preserve racing **History** From the **50's-60's and 70's**.

Our Drivers come from Georgia, North Carolina, Tennessee, Alabama and Florida. They average 170 miles one way towing. (Makes for long evenings and late mornings.)

We run 2 classes of Late Model and 2 of Open Wheel

The Two Late Model Classes' major difference is in the rear suspension.

- The Sportsman Class has leaf spring rear suspension.
- The Modified Class has newer rear suspension.

The Two Open Wheel Classes' main difference is in the front suspension. One class has the straight axel and the other has an A-Frame front suspension. **In each feature race there are two first place winners - one from each class in that race.**

Our pay-off is quite different, each driver gets paid the same whether they finish First or Last.

- We do give trophies for the first three positions in each class each night
- We keep points and have a banquet at the end of the year. The trophies are given out to the first Three drivers in each class.

- Our Championship may be determined by who makes every race, not necessarily the fastest car. This is because of the points you get for attendance as well as where you place in the race.
